

## City of Downey Electric Vehicle Charging Stations Project

In March of 2016, the Downey City Council approved an AB2766 Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Committee (MSRC) grant agreement, in the amount of \$40,000, with the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) for the design, procurement and installation of four publicly accessible electrical vehicle charging stations.

The four dual-unit charging stations were installed and made fully operational in December of 2016 at the following locations:

- City of Downey Library, South Parking Lot, located at 11121 Brookshire Avenue
- City of Downey Civic Center, West Parking Lot located at 11111 Brookshire Avenue
- City of Downey Parking Structure, located at 8201 Second Street
- Barbara J. Riley Community & Senior Center/Apollo Park, located at 7810 Quill Drive

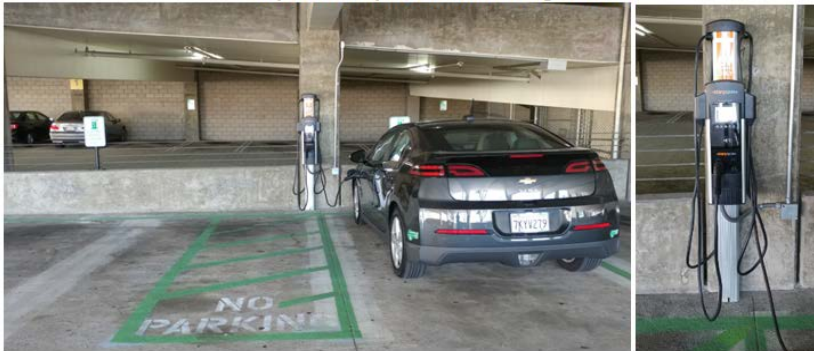
